CAIRNGORM SNOWSPORTS MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2009/2010

1. A snowsports member pass is valid for skiing from 1st December and for skiing on those dates that uplift operates for the purpose of downhill skiing, during standard opening hours.
2. The snowsports membership pass will be honoured until lifts cease to operate for skiing and snowboarding.
3. The snowsports membership pass is non transferable, and no refunds will be made.
4. The snowsports membership pass 09/10 may be used by the holder for funicular use during the summer months. When using your snowsports membership pass during the summer, please present your pass at the Ticket Office, where a funicular ticket will be issued.
5. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd accepts payment by cash, cheque, all major debit/credit cards (excluding American Express) and by standing order (details from ticket office). Company cheques are only accepted by prior arrangement.
6. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd reserves the right to change prices and services at any time and without notification.
7. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd retains the right to close all or any of the lifts at any time, for any reason. Snowsports members are reminded that lift operations can be affected by weather and snow conditions.
8. The Company's facilities are used at the pass holder's own risk. The Company accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage unless as a direct result of its negligence.
9. If a snowsports membership pass is lost during the current winter season, there will be a £20.00 administration fee to produce a duplicate.
10. If a snowsports member wishes to ski and is unable to produce their pass on the day, they will be issued with a complimentary day ticket. If they forget their membership pass more than three times during the season, they will be asked to pay the price of a day ticket (£30 2009/10).
11. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd reserves the right to limit the number of snowsports membership passes sold. In this eventuality, applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis.
12. The pass must be shown upon request by any member of CairnGorm Mountain Ltd staff, before uplift is used.
13. The carriage of sports equipment unrelated to piste skiing is not permitted on the funicular.
14. The pass is sold subject to the user's compliance with the skier's international code of conduct.
15. The pass is sold on the understanding that the holder will undertake all activity respecting the European Conservation Site Boundaries.
16. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in forfeiture of the snowsports pass.
17. Outwith the ski season, visitors are required to remain within the Ptarmigan building and viewing terrace, returning to the Base Station using the funicular, although they may walk up to the Ptarmigan Top Station and descend by the funicular.

NB: Please be aware that during the ski season, the ticket office can become extremely busy. It is therefore difficult for staff to process snowsports membership passes "on the spot." To avoid frustration and disappointment, please submit your application in good time. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Fully completed and signed the snowsports member application form.
- Included your payment details.
- New applicants have emailed a passport - photograph of yourself to members@cairngormmountain.org or enclosed a passport size photo (min 300dpi) on photo quality paper. Please name all photos.
